Sub: *Request to provide forensic evaluation and interpretation report on results of NAA analysis; Pharmacological and Medico-legal assessment based on NAA report and brief background provided herewith, issuing relevant reports on the cause and manner of death of Swami Srila Prabhupada-Reg.*

1. In reference to the subject cited above, I request Truth Labs to provide Forensic evaluation and interpretation of NAA analysis results, Pharmacological and Medico-legal aspects of the cause and manner of death of Swami Srila Prabhupada (SP) based on the following documents submitted:

- *NAA Analysis Report of Sample 'Q1' by Dr. J. Steven Morris, Leader, Nuclear Analysis Program, University of Missouri-Columbia, Research Reactor Centre, MO 65211 dated 6th January, 1999.*
- *NAA Analysis Report of Samples 'D', 'A', 'J', 'ND-2', 'M' and 'Q2' by Dr. J. Steven Morris, Leader, Nuclear Analysis Program, University of Missouri-Columbia, Research Reactor Centre, MO 65211 dated 23rd November, 2015.*
- *Instrumentation details and methods of analysis of NAA provided by the Associates of Dr. J. Steven Morris, MURR.*
- *Brief background and history of Srila Prabhupada, Founder ISKCON - A Bio-sketch.*
- *The medical history of Srila Prabhupada containing his health conditions in 1976 and 1977, before his death as well as data relating to his intake of food, liquids, ayurvedic drugs and medicines etc.*

2. The normal average levels of four metallic poisons in accordance with the messages, mails and reports of Dr. J. Steven Morris are as follows: Arsenic (As) 0.13 ppm, Cadmium (Cd) 0.07 ppm, Antimony (Sb) 0.08 ppm and Mercury (Hg) 1 ppm.
3. I request you to issue a Forensic Evaluation and Interpretation Report and Pharmaco-Pathological and Medico-Legal Assessment Reports based on the information provided herewith, and give your findings on the following issues amongst others:
 - a. Whether SP was poisoned with heavy metals like Cadmium and Arsenic etc.? If yes, whether the said poisoning was acute or chronic?
 - b. Whether the symptoms of poisoning by Cadmium etc. correlate with the health conditions of SP in late 1976 and 1977 before his death?
 - c. Whether the said poisoning was due to ingestion of the heavy metals like Cadmium etc. or can it be due to the exposure to external factors like normal environment of soil, air, water, food, massage oils, consumer products, hair clipper oil, and/or ayurvedic medicines?
 - d. Whether the caretakers/ close attendants of SP can be responsible for poisoning him by giving him food, drinks, and medicines tainted with Cadmium etc.?
 - e. Whether the high levels of Cadmium etc. found in the hair samples of SP before his death were sufficient to cause his death?

Besides the above mentioned queries, you may also cover the other aspects related to the cause and manner of the death of SP.
